The Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (OPRHP) has reviewed the information submitted for this project. Our review has been in accordance with Section 14.09 of the New York Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation Law and relevant implementing regulations.

The OPRHP has reviewed the Phase IB Survey Report submitted for this project. Our office concurs with the recommendation for avoidance of the sites identified during the investigation. The sites can be avoided through redesign and if necessary through the use of protective measures such as temporary fencing with notations on the construction plans. These protective measures help to ensure that sites in close proximity to the Area of Potential Effect (APE) are not inadvertently impacted during construction.

The OPRHP has no further archeological concerns for the project as currently designed if the avoidance and protective measures are implemented.
